



Legacy Health in collaboration with Oregon Health & Science University Kaiser Permanente and Adventist Health will open Unity Center for Behavioral Health in the fall of 2016. The Unity Center for Behavioral Health is expected to be a national model for providing compassionate mental health care in times of need. This unprecedented collaboration of four health systems shares the goal of providing care for all those in need through a combination of emergency, inpatient and robust transition to outpatient services and embraces the concepts of hope, recovery and resilience. The center will serve as a model setting to train a wide range of future healthcare providers.

The Unity Center will include 22 beds for adolescents, 79 adult patient beds, a Psychiatric Emergency Service and will also collocate navigators from organizations that provide community behavioral health services, helping to coordinate continued support to patients after discharge. The Psychiatric Emergency Service will be the only one of its kind in the Pacific Northwest.

PES Nurse Manager – This position will be employed by **Legacy Health** and will report to the Director of Patient Care for Unity. Reporting to this position will be the nursing staff for the PES. The Nurse Manager will serve as the accountable department manager and have responsibility for all daily operational activities including departmental planning for staffing, scheduling, budgeting and will ensure adequate systems and process for the efficient delivery of care and outstanding patient experience. The PES will provide patient care 24/7.

This position requires the ability to obtain an RN license in the state of Oregon, BSN/MSN required. Candidates may be considered with verification of Master's degree in progress. This position requires previous psychiatric experience as a RN and a minimum of two years of leadership. A collaborative manner and commitment to family-centered care will be very important.
